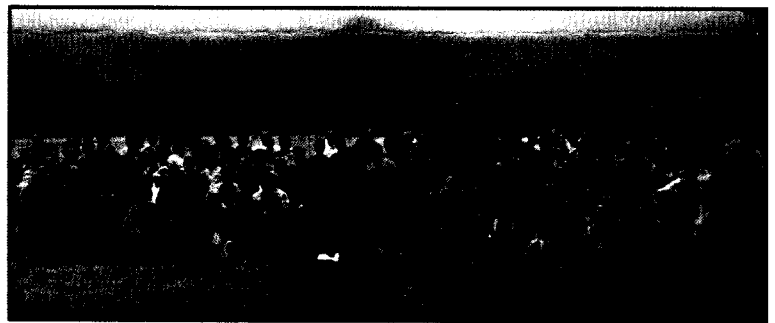
Warrior Baptist Church:
